Why we pray to Mary: As a role model and someone who has completed her earthly life, like the saints, we ask Mary to pray for us and to intercede on our behalf. Ultimately our prayers are always directed to God, but Mary helps us on our way to the Father. She is the Mother of God who freely said 'yes' to bringing Jesus into the world, to bringing him up and watching Him suffer and die. This makes her a unique path to God.

Pray the Rosary: Meditating on one decade is a great introduction to the Rosary. With even younger children, saying a prayerful 3 Hail Mary's will help lay the foundations of this great prayer. Another option to keep children focused is to add a phrase before each Hail Mary. For example. (The same could be done for other mysteries.) The crowning of Mary as Queen of Heaven.

- Mary is welcomed into heaven by her loving Son. Hail Mary ...
- God the Father and the Holy Spirit welcome her. Hail Mary ...
- She is crowned by her Son, Queen of heaven and earth. Hail Mary ...
- She is crowned Queen of Heaven and Earth. Hail Mary...
- She is called Queen because she is the mother of the king of Kings. Hail Mary...
- Mary loves us with all her heart. She is our Mother too. Hail Mary...
- Mary cares for us all and she always prays for us. Hail Mary ...
- Mary is always ready to listen to our thoughts and feelings. Hail Mary ...
- As Queen of Peace, we ask Mary to be with all those people who are suffering because of war. Hail Mary ...
- Let us place our parish and our school under the Queenship and protection of Mary, and ask her to care for us. Hail Mary ... Glory be to the Father ...
